Log in to Clever (on student homepage for lpisd), click on ICEV, then our class. Look for the section: "Employability Skills"

Employability Skills:

You will receive three grades for this week.

Employability Skills Notes:

- 1. Under this section there is a powerpoint, one sets of notes, one assessment, and you will also do the student vocabulary activity
- 2. Open the Powerpoint, and the notes under the **interactive** tab (Employability Skills- Student Notes) I suggest opening the notes and powerpoint in two separate windows, then minimizing both windows so you can see them at the same time. As you view the powerpoint you will complete the student notes

- 3. Once you complete the notes, go to TEAMS for our class, find the assignment that says "Employability Skills Notes", open the Assignment and hit "Turn in". (You do not need to attach anything, I will go in to ICEV and get your grade, this will just let me know when you complete it.)
- 4. Your grade will be your score on the notes.

Student Vocabulary- Employability Skills

- 1. While you are logged in to ICEV, go back to the "Employability Skills" link. Under the interactive tab, you will see an activity that says "Employability Skills: Vocabulary".
- 2. After you complete the student notes, you will do this activity. You will match definitions to vocabulary words from the powerpoint and notes.
- 3. Once you complete the vocabulary activity, log in to TEAMS for our class, find the assignment that says "Employability Skills Vocabulary". Hit turn in. You do not need to attach anything for this assignment.
- 4. Your grade will be based on correct answers given on the Vocabulary activity. You have 2 attempts, so if you do not do well on the first try, you may re-take it once.

Employability Skills Assessment

- 1. While you are logged in to ICEV, go back to the "Employability Skills" link.
- 2. You will see 1 assessment. You will take the assessment. You have two attempts, so if you do not do well the first time, you can re-take it once.
- Once you complete the assessment, log in to TEAMS for our class, find the assignment that says "Employability Skills Assessment". Hit turn in. Again, you do not need to attach anything, this will just let me know when you have completed it, and I can retrieve your grade from ICEV.
- 4. Your assessment will be graded based on answers given. It will be counted as a daily grade, not a test grade.
