Activities

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Student Activities:

- The student will continue working on unit on Who's Calling. This unit focuses on phone skills and etiquette needed in everyday routines. Students will learn the importance of using manners when making and receiving calls. The stories, articles, and activities will focus on the usefulness of phones, safe phone behaviors, and the responsibilities involved with owning a phone. Students will learn phone manners and tips while building their reading, math, daily living, and employability skills.
- The student will view Discovery Education Videos on possible careers and workplace skills to help them understand there are multiple options and pathways
