Week of 4/27 – studied and practiced for ESB Certification Test.

Objectives

We will assess our understanding of Entrepreneurship and Small Business concepts through Gmetrix ESB practice tests, and we will evaluate what concepts should be studied again. We will schedule and take our ESB Certification Test. We will explore essential workforce skills and our own soft skills strengths and areas to improve.

Activities

1. **Take your [ESB certification test](#)** during the scheduled and confirmed time. [How testing works:](#)
 - 1) I will schedule a time with Certiport close to the date and time you requested in [this form](#).
 - 2) **Respond** to the confirmation emails I send. I will send you an email confirming the date and time and with [instructions on preparing for the test administration](#).
 - 3) The day of the test if not the day before, I will send you your specific website URL to the test by email.
 - 4) The day of the test at the hour assigned the URL will work, and you can login to Certiport and take the test. I will be proctoring you through a screen reader. [Here is a video of what it will be like](#). It will be similar to the practice tests you've taken in Gmetrix. You will not be able to leave the screen for the timed 50 minute test. You will get your results right away at the end.
2. If you are not taking your test this week, (90 minutes) **Study for ESB**. Study 30 minutes of ESB concepts for 3 days or an hour and a half worth of time. Options:
 - 1) You can do this by taking or retaking practice exams at gmetrix.net
 - 2) by repeating training and labs at gmetrix.net
 - 3) and you can do this by tuning into the Teams General Posts and watching/reading ESB tips I will be sharing on our Teams General Post page.There will be an assignment link on Teams where you can submit **Study Proof Week 5/1**.
3. *You may complete this next week if you've decided to spend more than 2 hours this week on studying for the ESB certification test.* (30 minutes) Complete the **Soft Skills Reflection Activity** on Teams. This a word document to read and fill in. You should be able to click the triple dots on the attachment in the Teams assignment and choose to edit the document in Word Online. Make sure to submit the assignment when you are finished.
