
# LPHS SPED – FOCUS – VOCATIONAL Outreach Learning April 20 – April 24, 2020



#### Objective / I Can:

- I can effectively ask and respond to questions with community, daily living, and vocational activities.
- I can participate in conversations related to current events in my community and beyond.
- I can understand and apply vocabulary related to community, daily living, and vocational situations.
- I can demonstrate an understanding of needing to be employed and recognize realistic job options.
- I can apply problem-solving skills to issues related to daily living situations.
- I can create a solution to a problem based on a problem-solving process.
- I can refrain from rushing through a task or not clarify directions to get a task done.
- I can complete tasks in required time limit with no verbal prompts.
- I can start and complete a task and then move onto new task with no verbal reminders.
- I can follow the directions to complete a task.
- I can demonstrate understanding, through verbal or written responses, about various jobs and careers.
- I can when given a task, gather the materials needed to complete the task with no more than one verbal reminder.

# **Activities**

Student Activities:

- The student will begin working on the unit Work it! This unit investigates work skills including teamwork and following directions. Students will learn important tips for getting a job and essential skills to keep a job. The lessons and activities focus on the value of good work attitudes and behaviors. Students will learn about the importance of asking for help when needed, using good manners, and staying on task.

- The student will view Discovery Education Videos on possible careers and workplace skills to help them understand there are multiple options and pathways.

- The student will complete at least 2-3 work tasks a week from the Vocational Choice Board 3 to further their IEP Goals and vocational skills at home.
