 - Explain the impact Clarisse's appearance then sudden disappearance on Montag.
 - Contrast the tone and writing style of the scenes involving Clarisse versus those taking place in the firehouse when Montag is at work.
 - How has Montag's identity as an individual begun to diverge (move away) from what is expected of him in society?
 - What is the demonstrated impact of books on Montag's thoughts and sense of self so far?
2. Complete the *Fahrenheit 451* Reading Quiz 1 in Teams using Forms. Links to the quiz will be posted in the Teams channel for each class.
